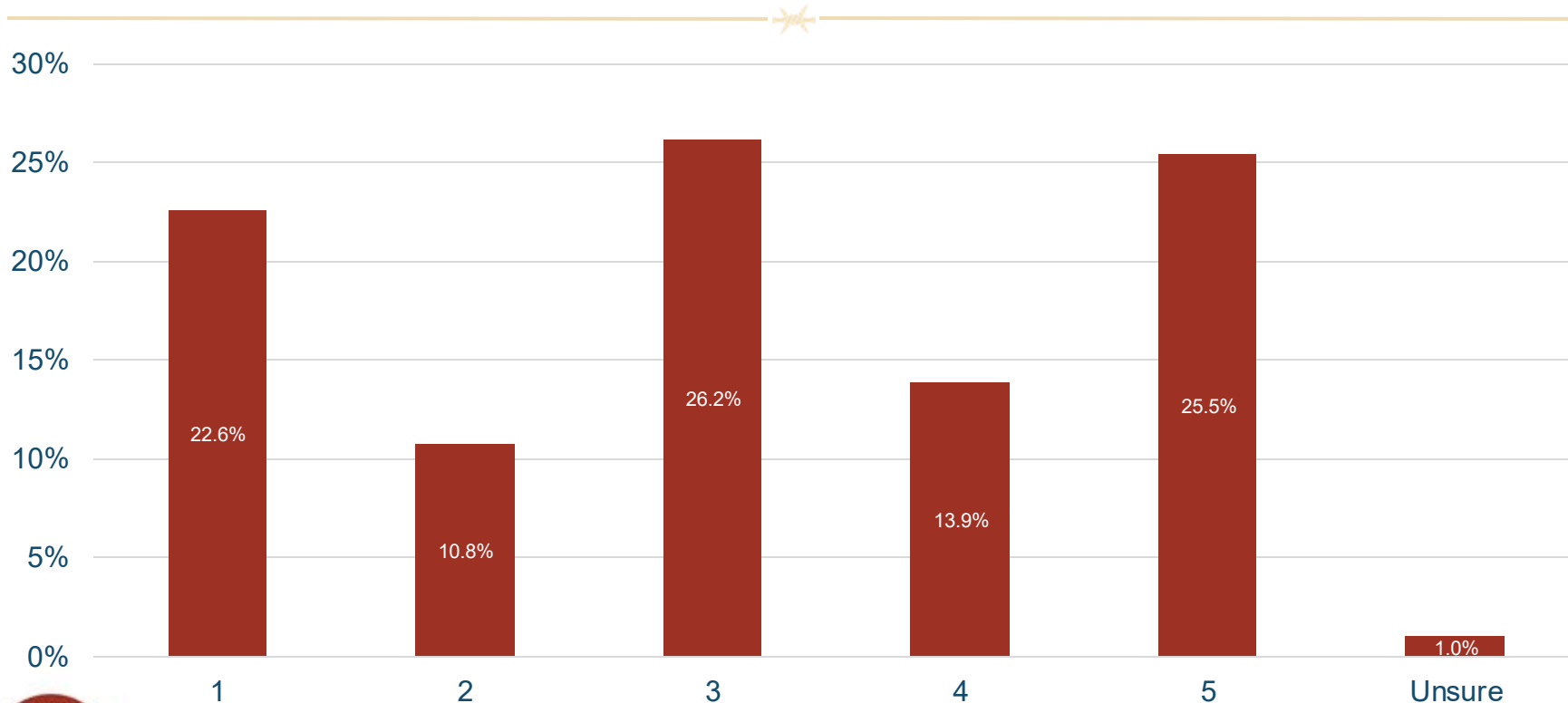
Q6. In your own words, what ONE issue is the biggest reason Louisiana's rural communities are in decline?



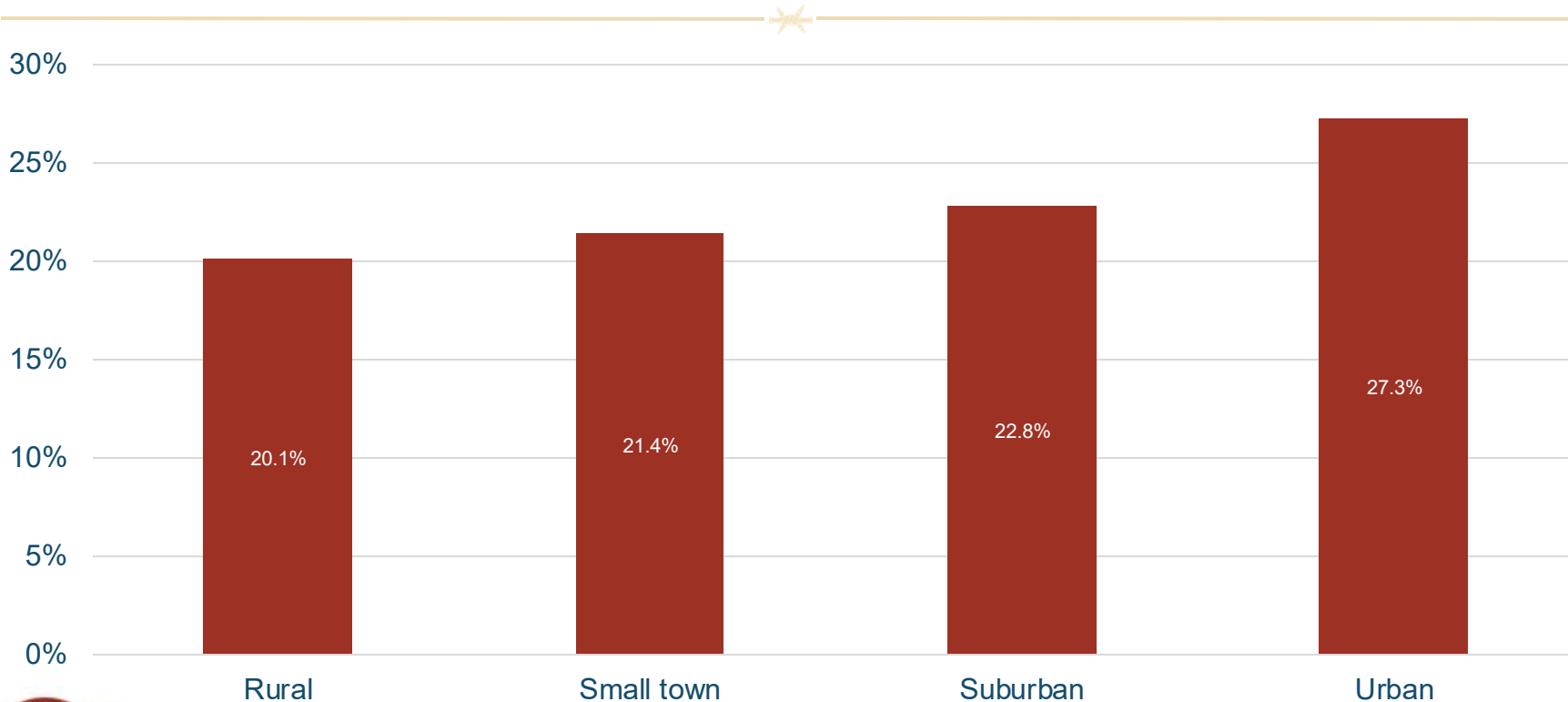

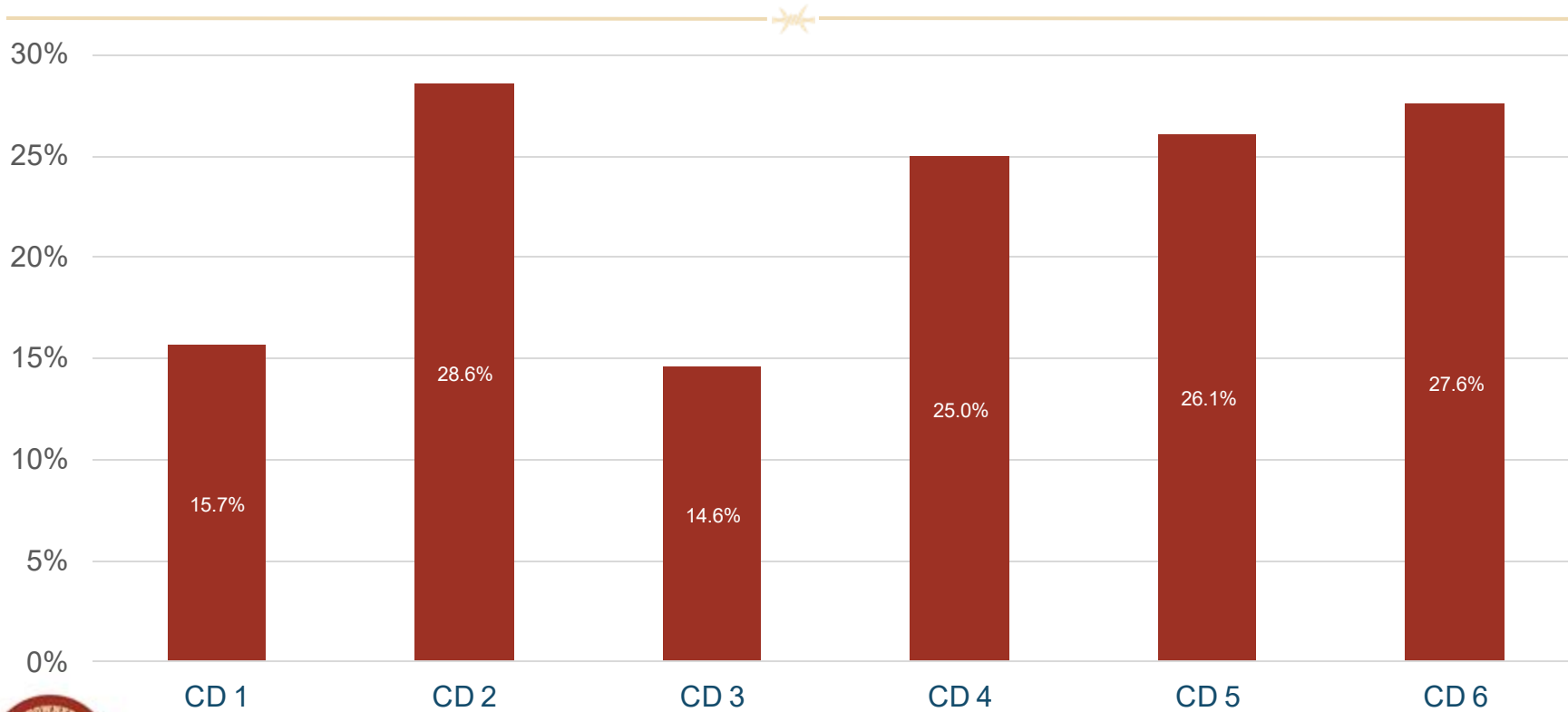

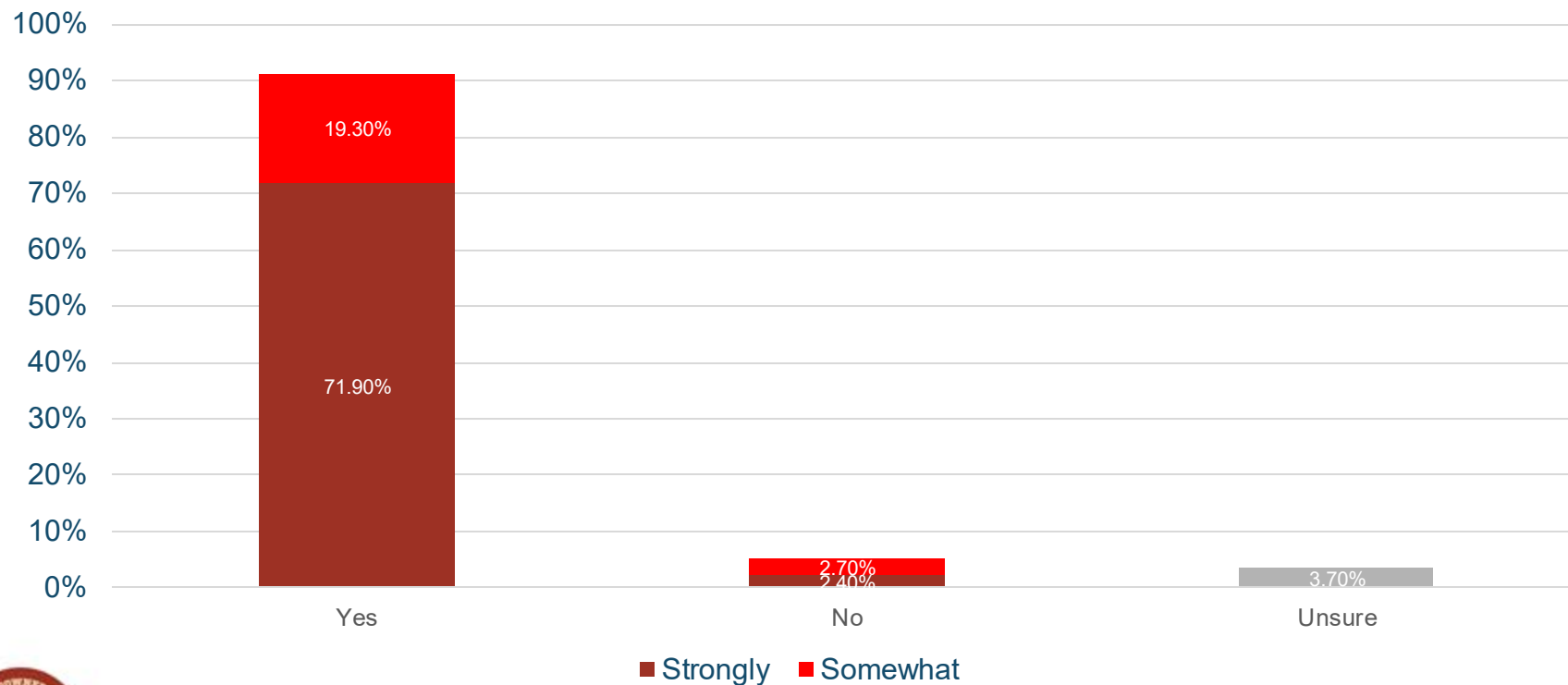

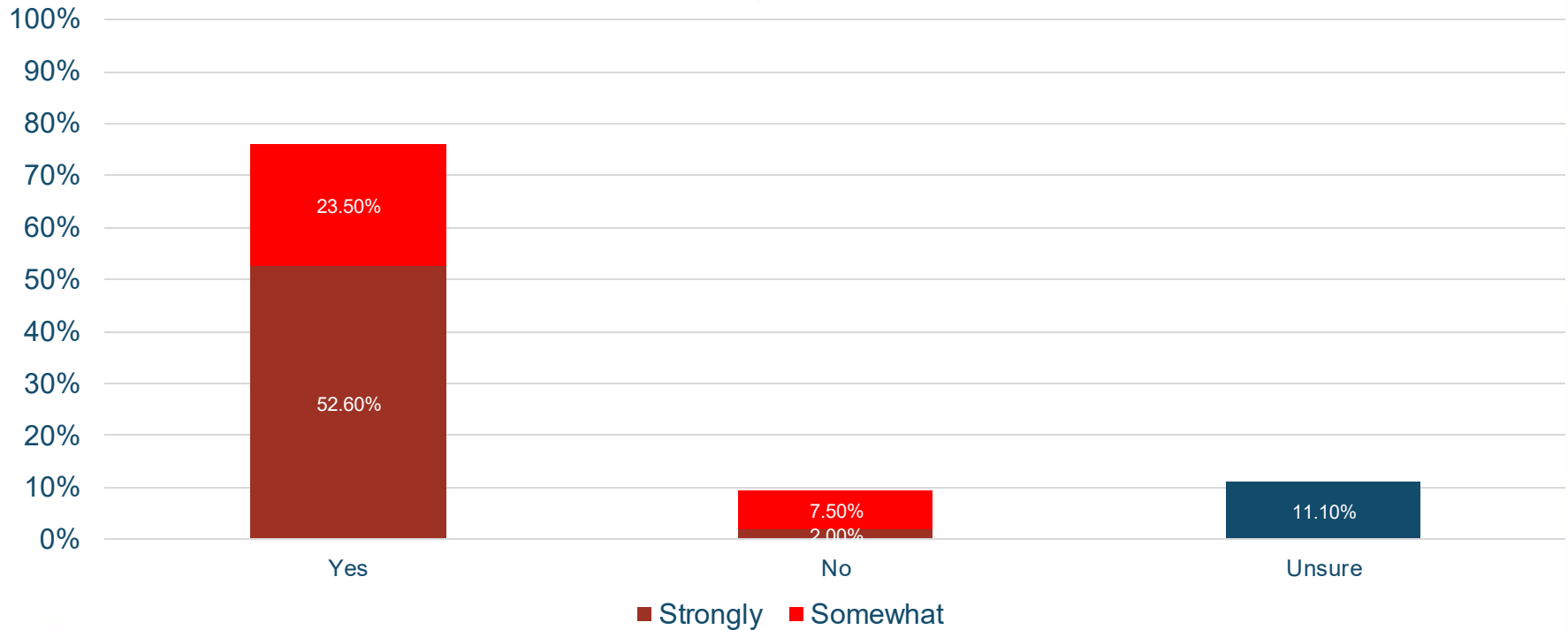

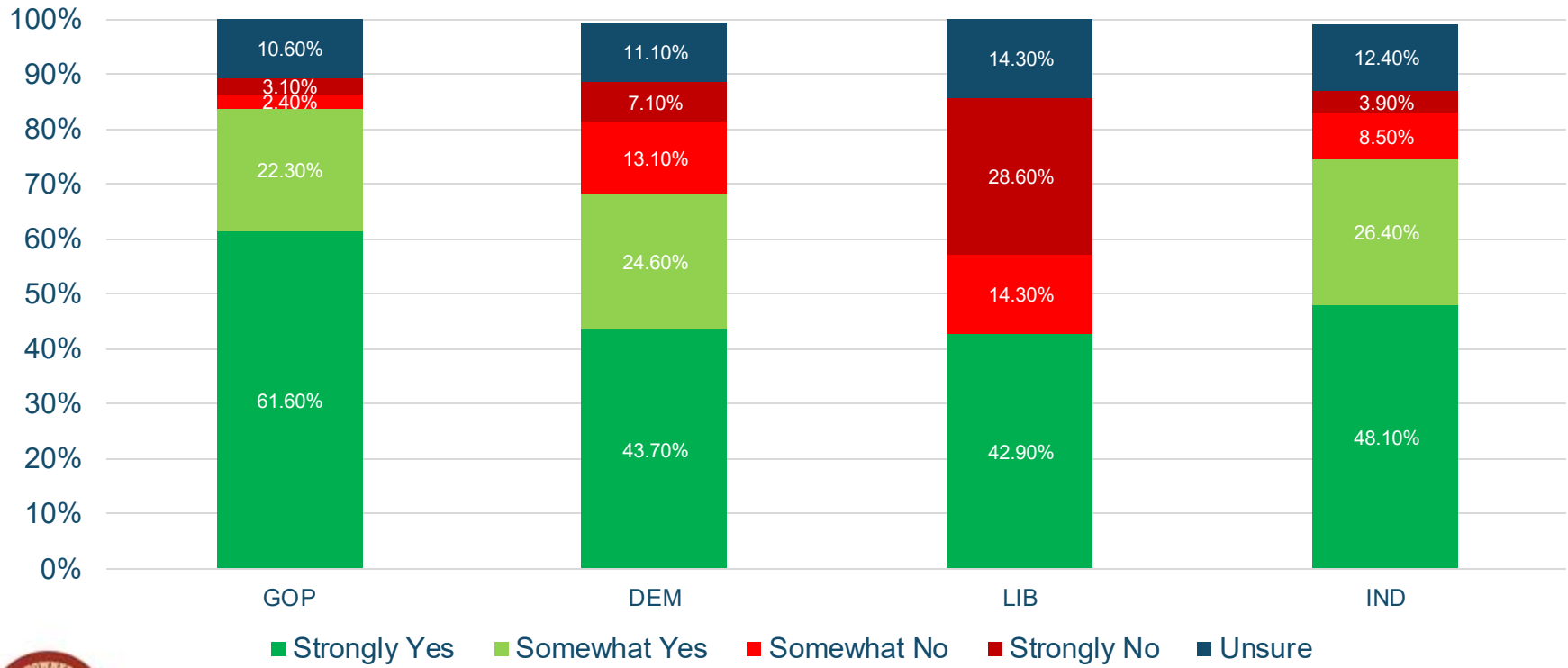

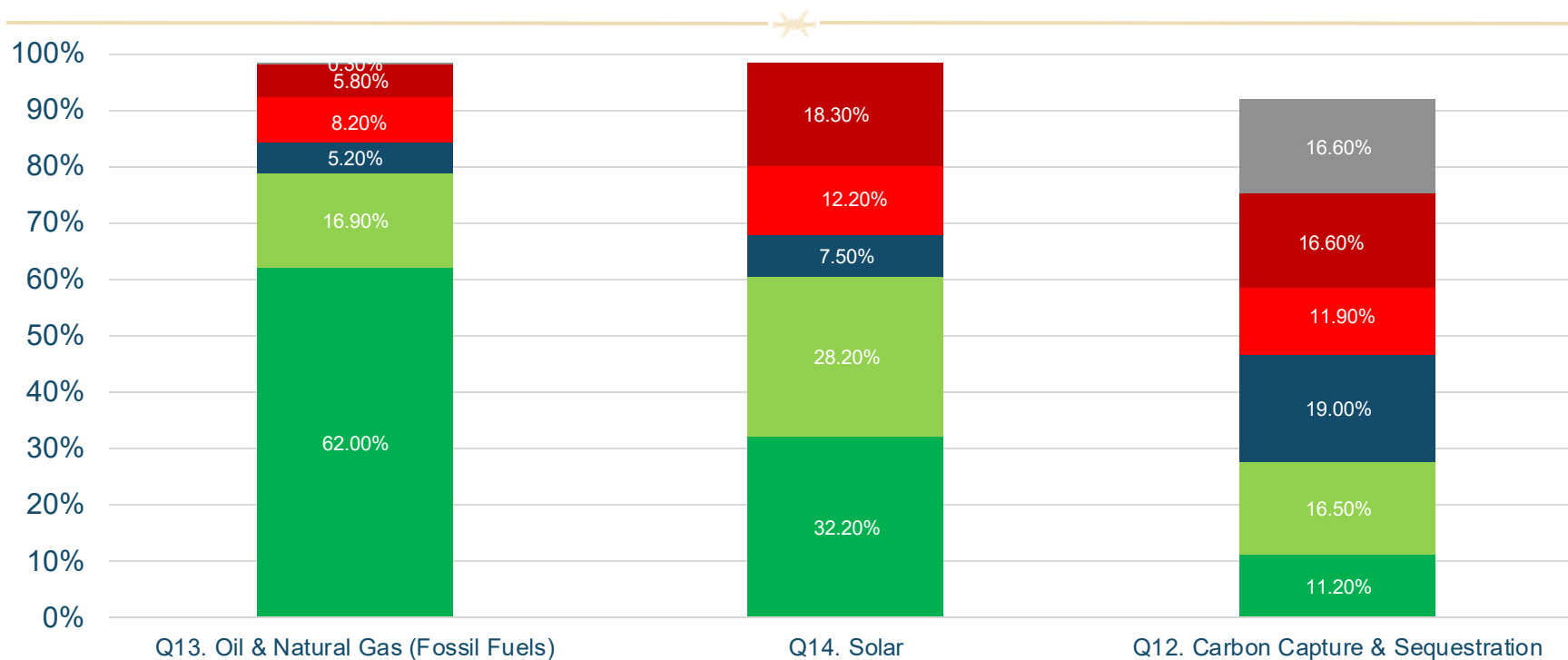

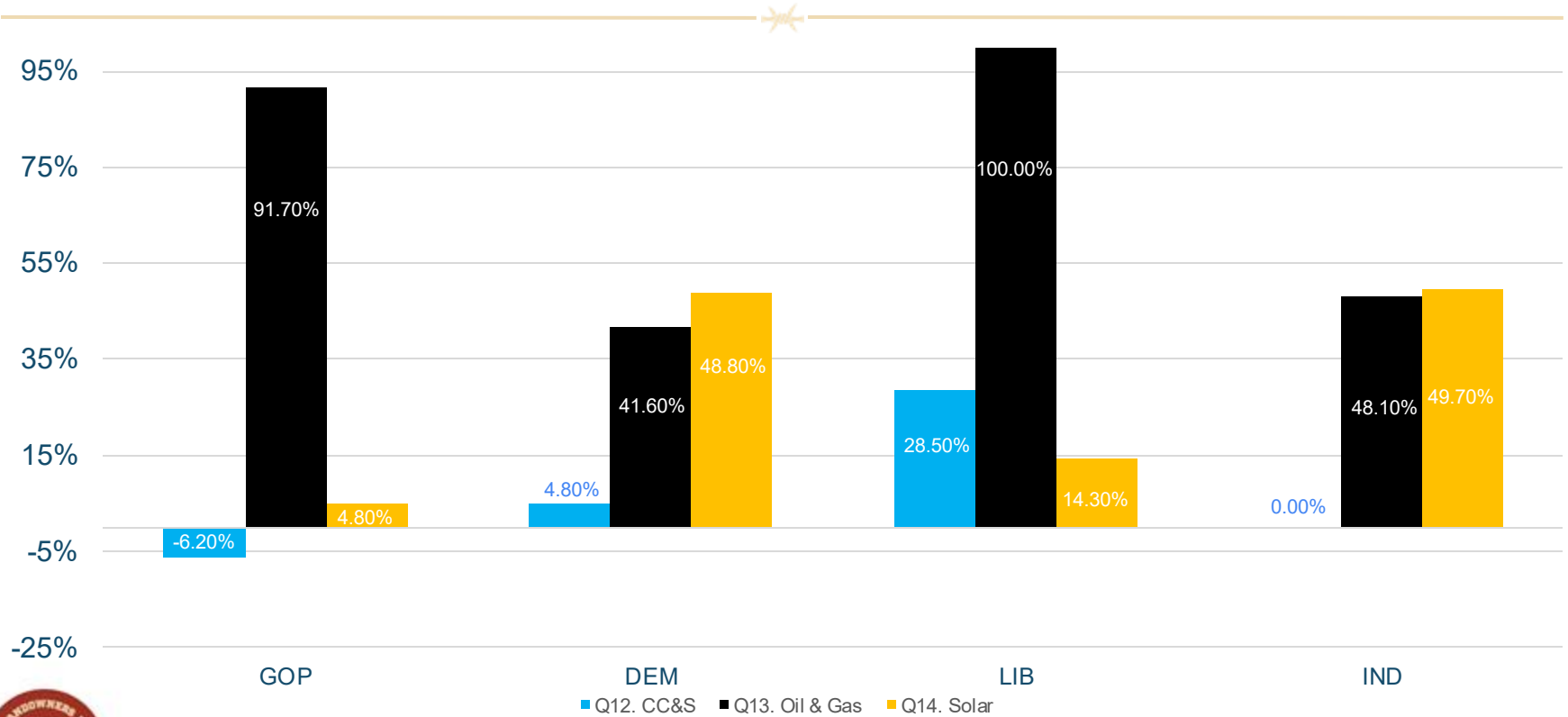

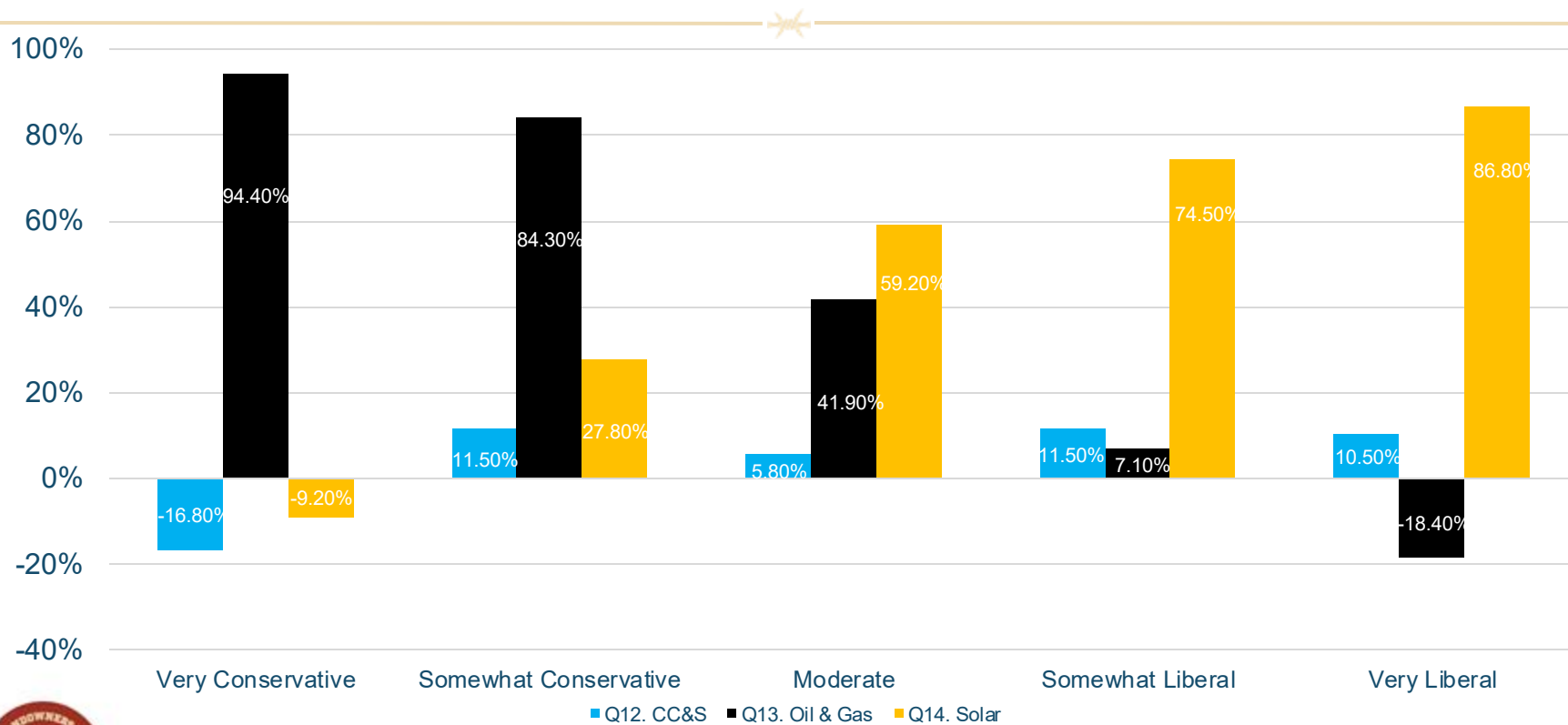

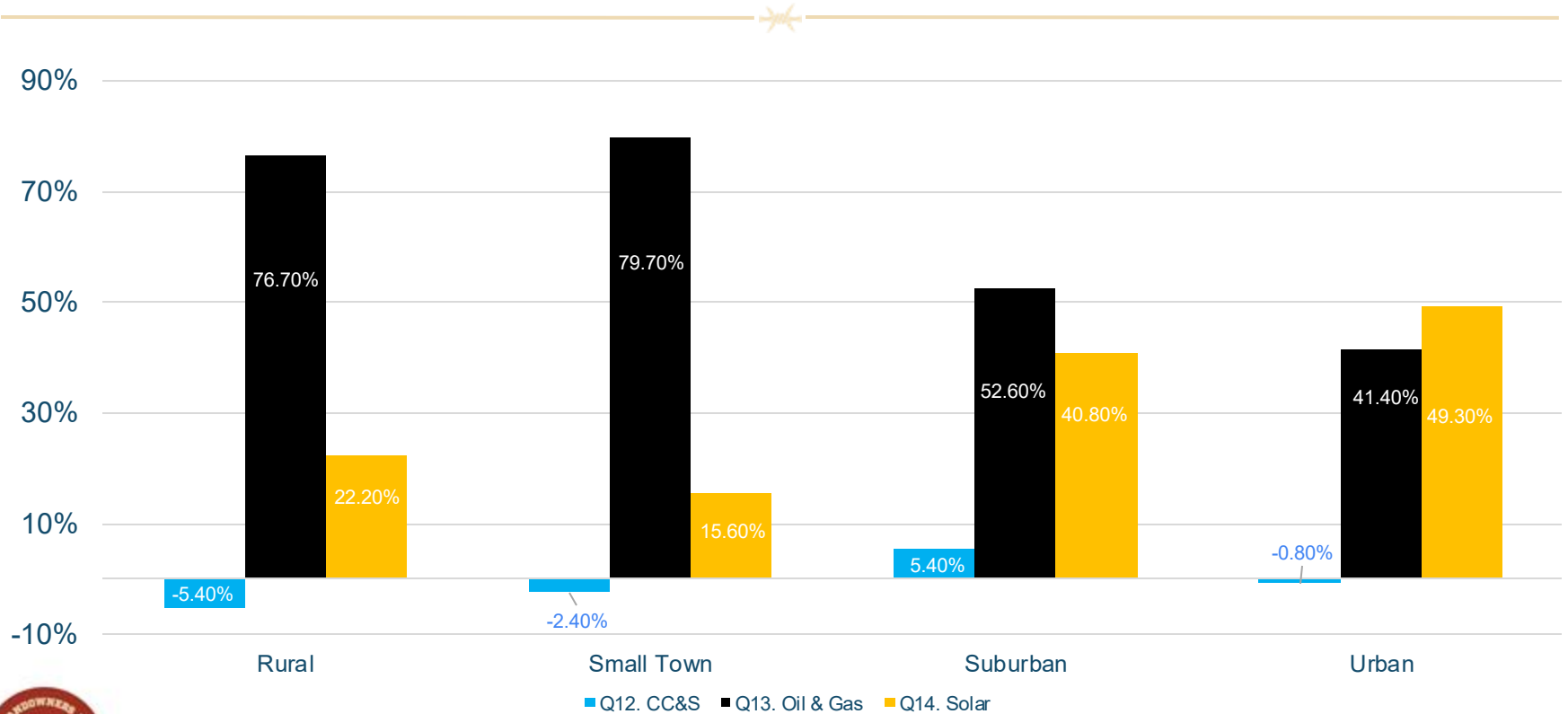
Qs 12-14 (Net Favorability by Party ID)



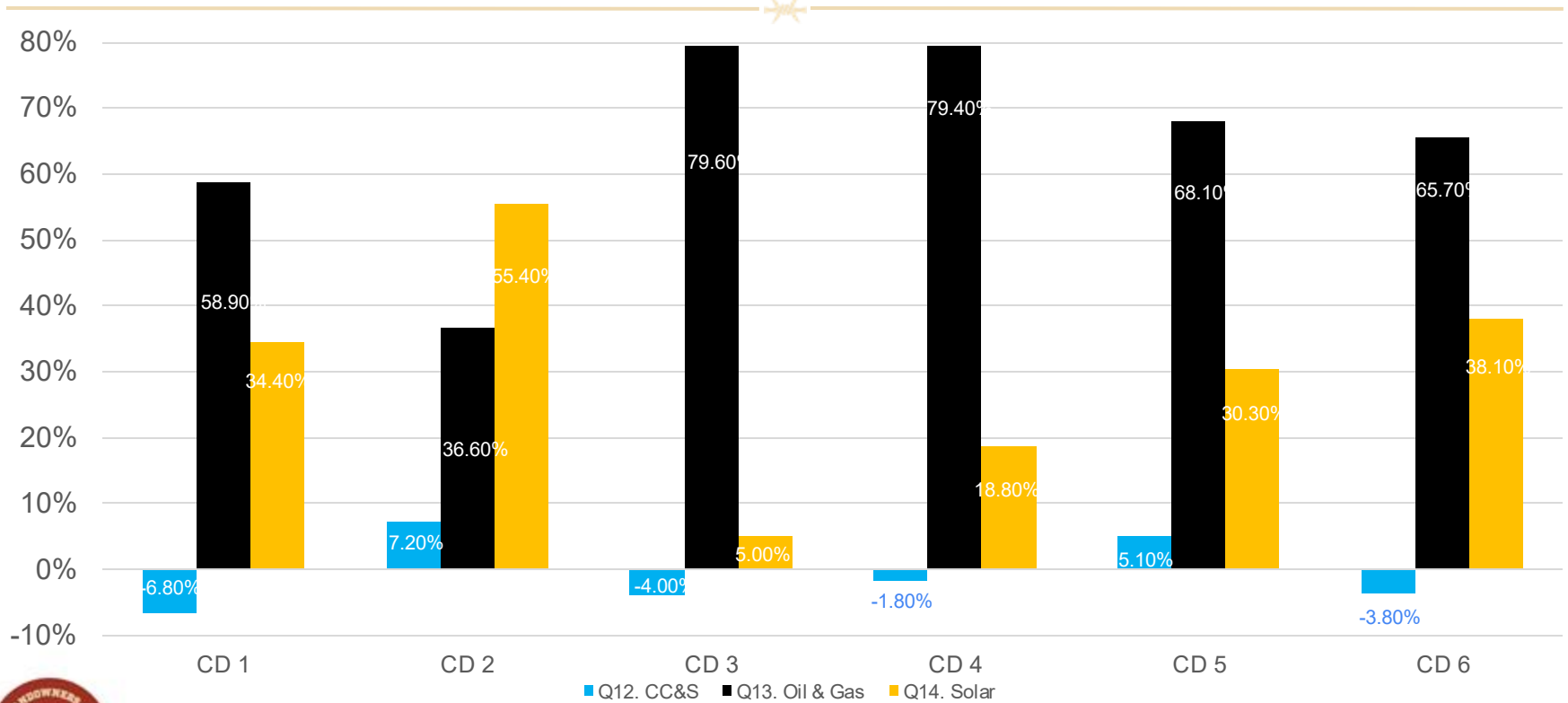
Qs 12-14 (Net Favorability by Ideology)



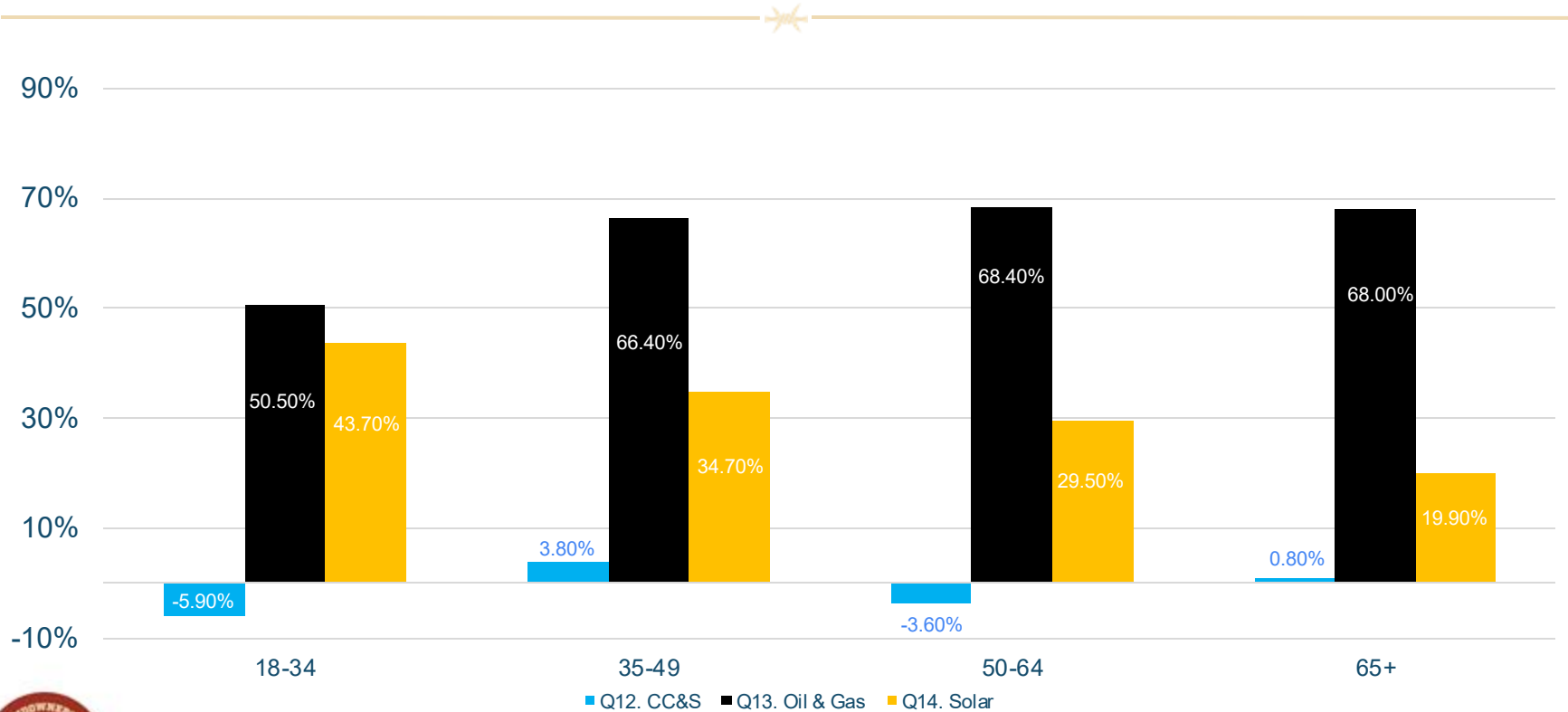

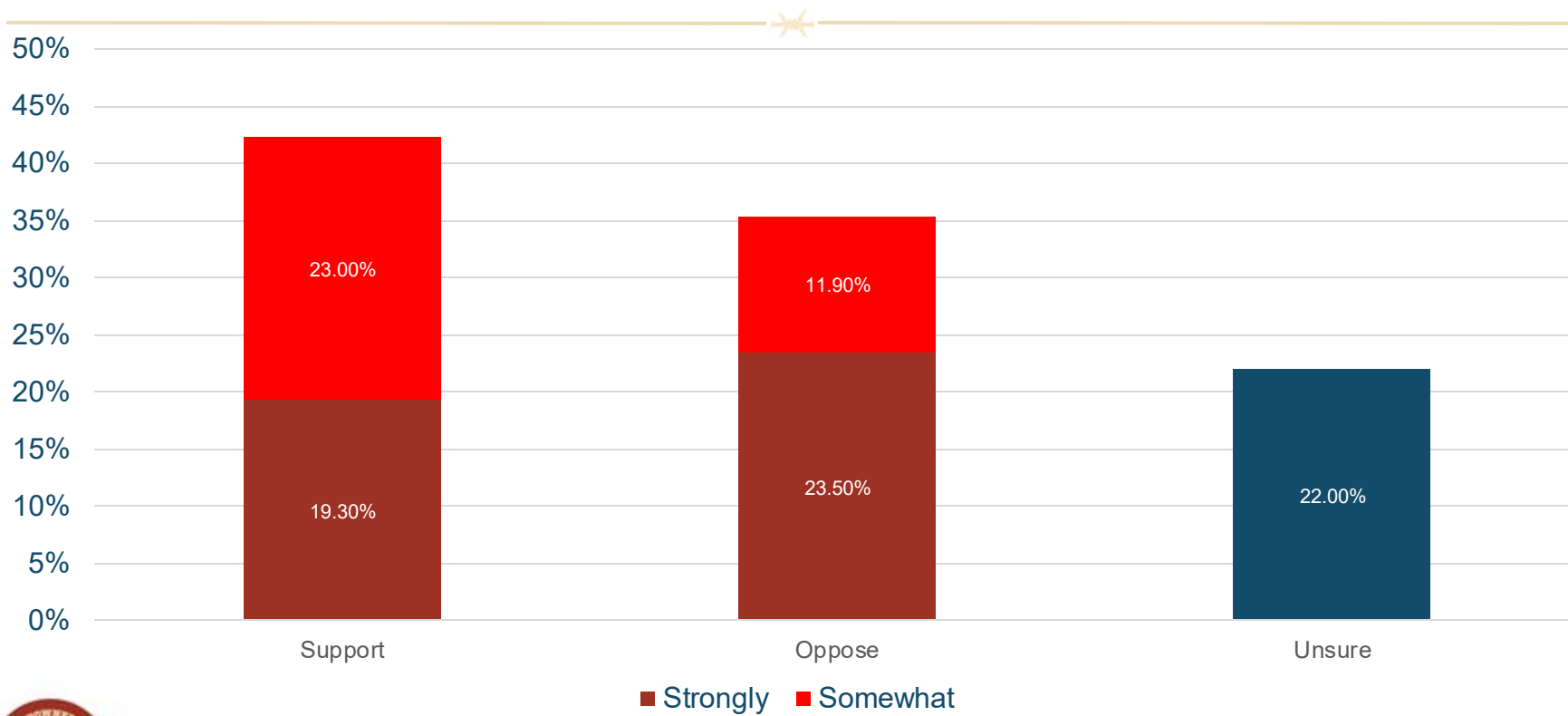

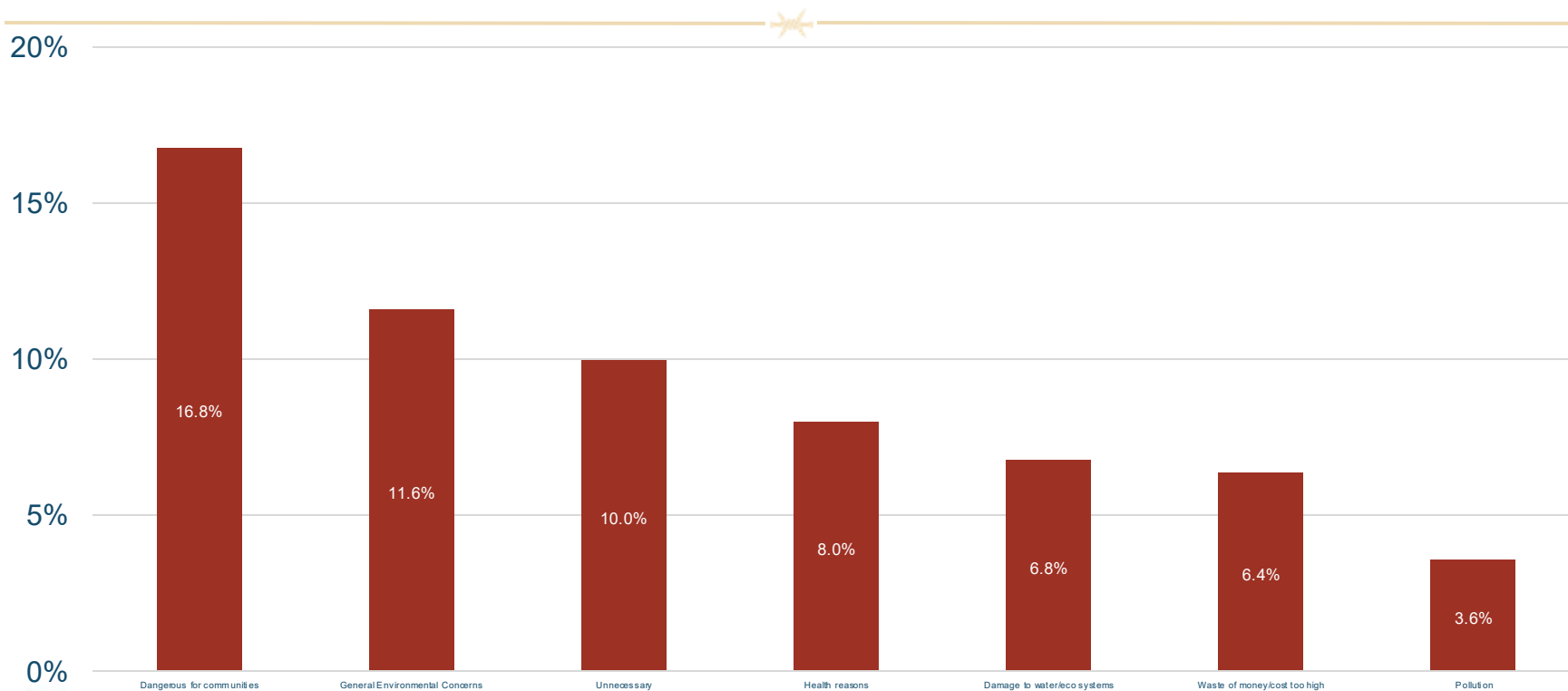

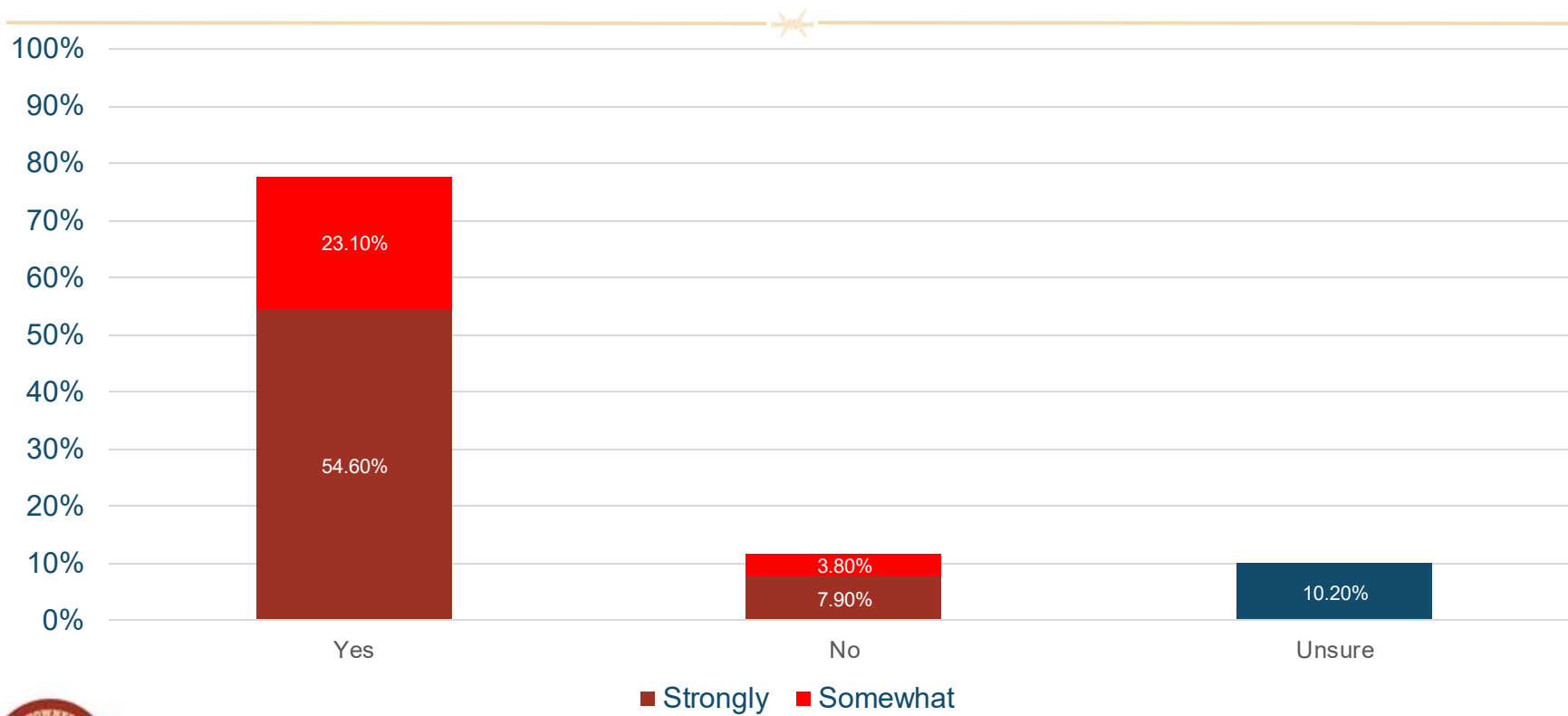

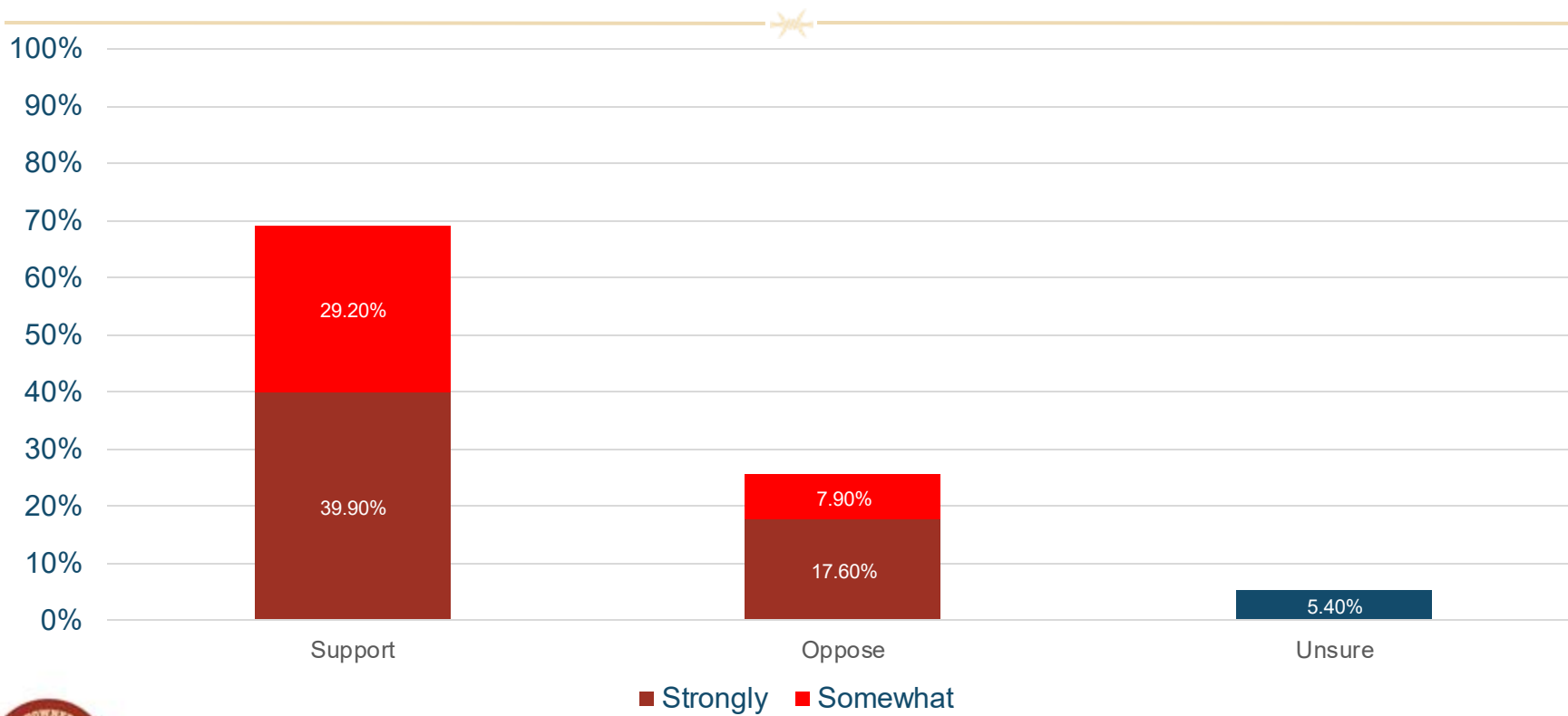
Q20. In your own words, what is the SINGLE most important reason you oppose building carbon capture and sequestration infrastructure in or around your community?



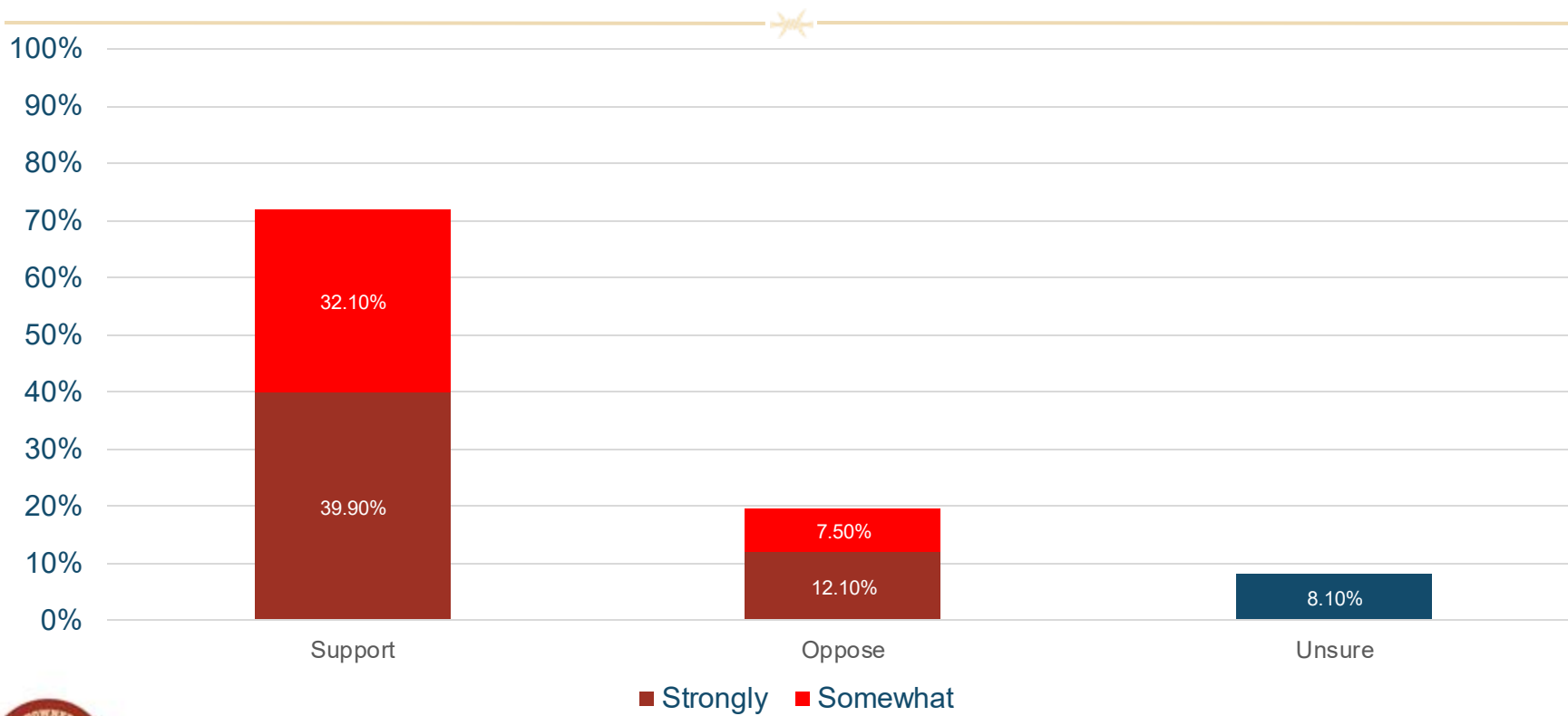
